We start in the summer by training teachers how to use Code.org's free, standards-aligned CS curricula. Teachers stay in a community of practice that continues over the first implementation year, attending quarterly workshops for additional support in teaching CS through project-based learning. Teachers can earn continuing education units for all training and workshops.
